MINUTES OF GENERAL BODY MEETING HELD ON 24TH JULY 2010, AT WARANGAL

The Following members were present:

President Prof. S.V. Ranga Rao, Vice President Prof. Venkateswarlu, Joint Secretary Dr. K. Babji, Treasurer Dr. B.S.V. Raju, all EC members and members of the APNSA.

1. President Prof. S.V. Ranga Rao was welcomed by the members of APNSA.
2. In the absence of Prof. A.K. Purohit, Secretary Report was presented by Dr. K. Babji (Joint Secretary) and was accepted by the General Body.
3. Treasurer's report was presented by Treasurer Dr. B.S.V. Raju, and it was approved by General Body and was accepted. A salary of Rs.3,000/- per month was approved by General Body the secretarial assistance.
4. Scientific programme have only 4 Guest lecturers and two orations from 2011 conference. It was proposed by Prof. M.R.C. Naidu seconded by Dr. P.S. Reddy and was approved by the General Body.
5. Senior members of APNSA advised that persons presenting their papers at APNSA conference must be either life/associate member and stick to time.
6. Vice president's election: Only one nomination from the floor was received for Prof. M.R.C. Naidu, Neurosurgeon, OGH, Hyderabad. His nomination was found valid.
7. Prof. M.R.C. Naidu was elected as Vice President unanimously. Prof. K.venkateswarulu will be the incoming president. As the tenure of all other executive members is for another two years, the executive committee remains unchanged.
8. Arogyasri: It was suggested by the General Body to make representation to the government regarding Arogyasri tariffs. The committee constituted earlier will discuss with other members regarding tariffs and various difficulties encountered in treatment of patients under arogyasri.
9. Next Conference: The 2011 APNSA conference will be held at Hyderabad. The organizing secretary will be Dr. Ameer Basha, Neurosurgeon, Care Hospital. The organizing committee and General Body wished the team of 18th APNSA conference all the best in making the conference a memorable event.
General Body agreed for hosting Annual conference of APNSA 2012 at Visakhapatnam by Dr. M.V. Sekhar, as the organizing secretary to host the. It was also noted and agreed by the General Body to have 2013 APNSA conference in Guntur with Dr. Ch. Siva Ramakrishna as the organizing secretary.
10. Membership: Ten new members were added during the last one year making the total strength of the association to 180. All executive members were requested to take up a special membership drive to make the total membership to 250 by the coming year.
11. The executive members and this General Body meeting participants were happy with the conduct of the meeting by Dr. T. Sanjay and his team. All the members expressed their profuse thanks to Dr. T.Sanjay and his team.
12. One time payment for postgraduates: It was agreed to enroll all post graduates as Temporary Associate Members on one time payment of Rs.3000/- and change to permanent membership on producing the degree certificate.
13. For any conferences or CME to be conducted by any members of the association under affiliation of the APNSA, a 25% facilitation fees to be collected from the organizers provided auditors do not have any objection.
14. Public awareness programmes: It was discussed regarding the feasibility and effectiveness of having public awareness programme every year with a theme throughout the state on a common neurological condition like seizures, stroke, head injuries etc. It was agreed to have further discussion on this in the next General Body meeting.
15. President thanked the General Body and adjourned the meeting.

MINUTES OF MID TERM APNSA EXECUTIVE MEMBERS MEETING HELD AT CARE HOSPITAL, HYDERABAD ON 20TH FEBRUARY, 2011 (11 AM TO 3 PM)

1. President Prof. K. Venkateswarlu welcomed the members.
2. The following executive members - Dr. Babji, Dr. M. Madhusudhan Rao, Dr. Ch. Sivaramakrishna could not attend the meeting because of various reasons.
3. Secretary's (Prof. A.K. Purohit) Report:
 - a) The process of getting the income tax exemption for the association has been started and would take around 4 months.
 - b) Membership drive: It was proposed to increase the membership of our association to 300 (presently it is 180) by enrolling all the unregistered neurospecialists by personally contacting at least the Head of the Departments in all the teaching hospitals to make their faculty and residents as members.
 - c) Secretary proposed that the Associate Life Member if pays Rs. 3,000/- (Instead of Rs. 750/- per annum), he/she may be given Life Membership later on producing award of degree certificate without any more membership fee. This might improve our membership drive. Members agreed to it as it was no way causing financial losses and was just an alternative provision to improve membership numbers.
 - d) It was suggested to send a representation to Arogyasri minister, for changes in neurosurgery/ neurology tariff, so that the missionary project can be improved and strengthened. A Core committee was formed with President Prof K.Venkateswarulu as the chairperson, with Secretary Prof. A.K. Purohit, Dr. T.V.R.K. Murthy and Dr. A.V.R. Murthy and another nominated neurology member from Hyderabad as members to suggest the revised tariff along with necessary documents to support the tariffs.
4. Treasurer's report was presented by Treasurer Dr. B.S.V. Raju, proposed by Prof. Satya Varaprasad and seconded by Dr. T.V. Ramakrishna Murthy.
5. It was informed that Dr. T. Sanjay has promised to send a contribution of around Rs. 40,000/- (as part of 20% of registration fees collected in Warangal APNSA conference). All members thanked Dr. T. Sanjay for excellent conduct of meeting and his contribution to APNSA.
6. It was suggested to collect Rs.5,00,000 (five lakh rupees) from Prof. S. V. Adinarayana rao towards Prof . S. Balaparameshwara Rao Symposium and Prof . K. Venkateswarulu has agreed to talk about the issue with Prof. S.V. Adinarayana Rao.

7. Discussion on Speakers and topics for various orations - Regarding Dr. Dayananda Rao oration, Dr. Muralidhar oration and Nellore Neuro Club sessions the names of the speakers will be suggested by and Prof. K.Venkateswarulu and Prof. M.R.C. Naidu/Prof. A.K. Purohit. They will talk to the speakers regarding neurology and neurosurgery respectively and will finalise the list in 4-6 weeks. Suggested the organizers to limit the total number of guest lectures to four.

10. Persons with outstanding contribution to the medical field preferably in the following order from Andhra Pradesh, Andhraites working outside Andhra Pradesh(In India or Abroad) and others (from India or Abroad).
11. They will be selected for orations and guest lectures. The contribution to the medical field should be the most preferable criteria while selecting the speakers.
